Planning for the Capital Campaign is underway! The Campaign Executive Team (CET)—Susan Kirby and pastors Jennifer and Scott—are meeting and pulling together plans for the proposed projects. We will soon be recruiting additional members to join us on the CET.

We have been receiving some questions about the Campaign, so we thought we would provide a list of FAQ's. Q. We've heard about the Capital Campaign for some time now. When will it begin?

A. January 2023

Q. Why the delay? We heard it would begin in the fall.

A. Our annual stewardship drive begins in October. Our UCC consultant discouraged us from having the Capital Campaign begin at the same time.

Q. Why not have them at the same time?

A. It would be confusing to try to fund both campaigns at the same time. The stewardship drive raises money for our annual expenses which include paying for staff salaries, utility bills, and committee expenses. As you know, we are entirely self-funded. It is critically important that we continue to maintain our daily operations. The Capital Campaign focuses upon specific projects, and the pledges will be paid over a period of three years.

Q. Will we have an opportunity to review the plans for the Capital Campaign?

A. Yes, the CET will hold listening and sharing events in September, both in person after church, and a Zoom meeting.
